**William G. McCallum** is a University Distinguished Professor of Mathematics and Head of the Department of Mathematics at the University of Arizona. Dr. McCallum received his Ph.D. in Mathematics from Harvard University. He has been a member of the Harvard calculus consortium since 1989 and is the lead author of the consortium's multivariable calculus and college algebra texts. He has received several awards including the Director's Award for Distinguished Teaching Scholars from the National Science Foundation and the American Mathematical Society Centennial Research Fellowship. In 2006, Dr. McCallum founded the Institute for Mathematics & Education at the University of Arizona. He was Director of the Institute until 2009 and currently chairs its advisory board. In 2009-2010, he led the work team that developed the NGA/CCSSO Common Core Math Standards. His professional interests include arithmetical algebraic geometry and mathematics education. He has received grants and written numerous articles, essays, and books in both areas.
